<u>Cole</u>: 4 Rescue Veneta grants have been passed before it sunset. Some of the remaining funds will be out toward the City's broadband efforts as well as City identity survey. Council voted to rezone the Enterprise zone. Updated council on wildfire reduction efforts that have been happening. <u>Matt</u>: Lane County is perusing mental health response county wide in addition to long-term sustainable housing, even in the rural areas. COV council donated \$1000 to Lane Arts Council as well as \$1500 to community dinners program. COV will pay the warming shelter on a per-night basis that they are open, that added up to around \$1200 that will roll into next year's budget for the shelter. National Public Works week is third week of May, Mayor read a proclamation about that. Utility billing collection scheme has been updated for COV and the language that goes along with that.
